- Hook Sentences. How to catch the readers attention.

TYPES OF HOOK SENTENCES

Good writers use interesting introductions for their stories. These are called hook sentences.

<p>Ask a Question</p> <p>Starting with a question for your reader may make them want to keep reading.</p>	<p>Describe a Setting</p> <p>You can start by adding descriptive details to describe the setting of the story.</p>	<p>Use Sound Words</p> <p>Sound words make the reader curious to see what your story will be about.</p>
<p>Use Dialogue</p> <p>You can start your story with words conversation to get the reader interested.</p>	<p>Use a Funny Moment</p> <p>You can start with a funny moment that makes the reader want to read more.</p>

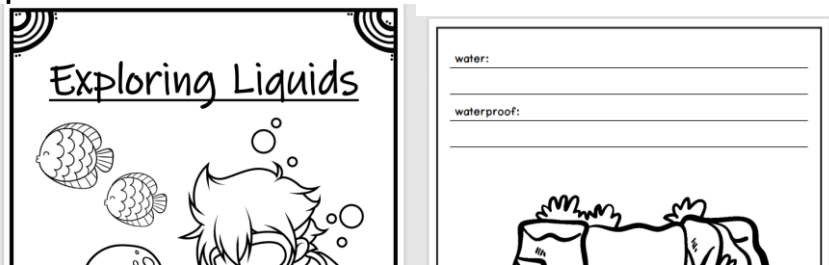
