- Write a Christmas story Plan:

1. **What is your Character? Describe your character and what his/her want is.**
2. **When and Where does the story take place? Have the character look or move around the setting and describe what they see.**
3. **What action happens in the story, have the character meet another character?**
4. **What trouble does your character get into?**
5. **How is the trouble solved?**
6. **Show a satisfying ending with words, actions and feelings.**


Each of these elements will be a different page of your story. Use today to plan your story. Sketch and write your plan on each of the six sections from class. Here is *an example* of a story.

<p>1. What is your Character? Describe your character and what his/her want is. Bear sleeps through Christmas and wants to stay awake.</p>
<p>2. When and Where does the story take place? Have the student look or move around the setting and describe what they see. Bear live in a dark cave and goes out into the snow.</p>
<p>3. What action happens in the story, have the character meet another character? Bear find Rabbit and asks if he missed Christmas.</p>
<p>4. What trouble does your character get into? Rabbit does not know if Christmas is over. They go to find Owl.</p>
<p>5. How is the trouble solved? Owl find them and tells them it is Christmas Eve.</p>
<p>6. Show a satisfying ending with words, actions, and feelings. They celebrate Christmas and are happy.</p>
