9:00- Reading Centers- Each centre should take 15 minutes.

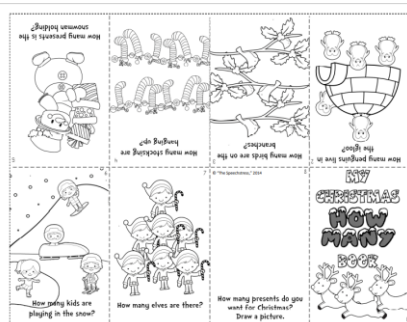

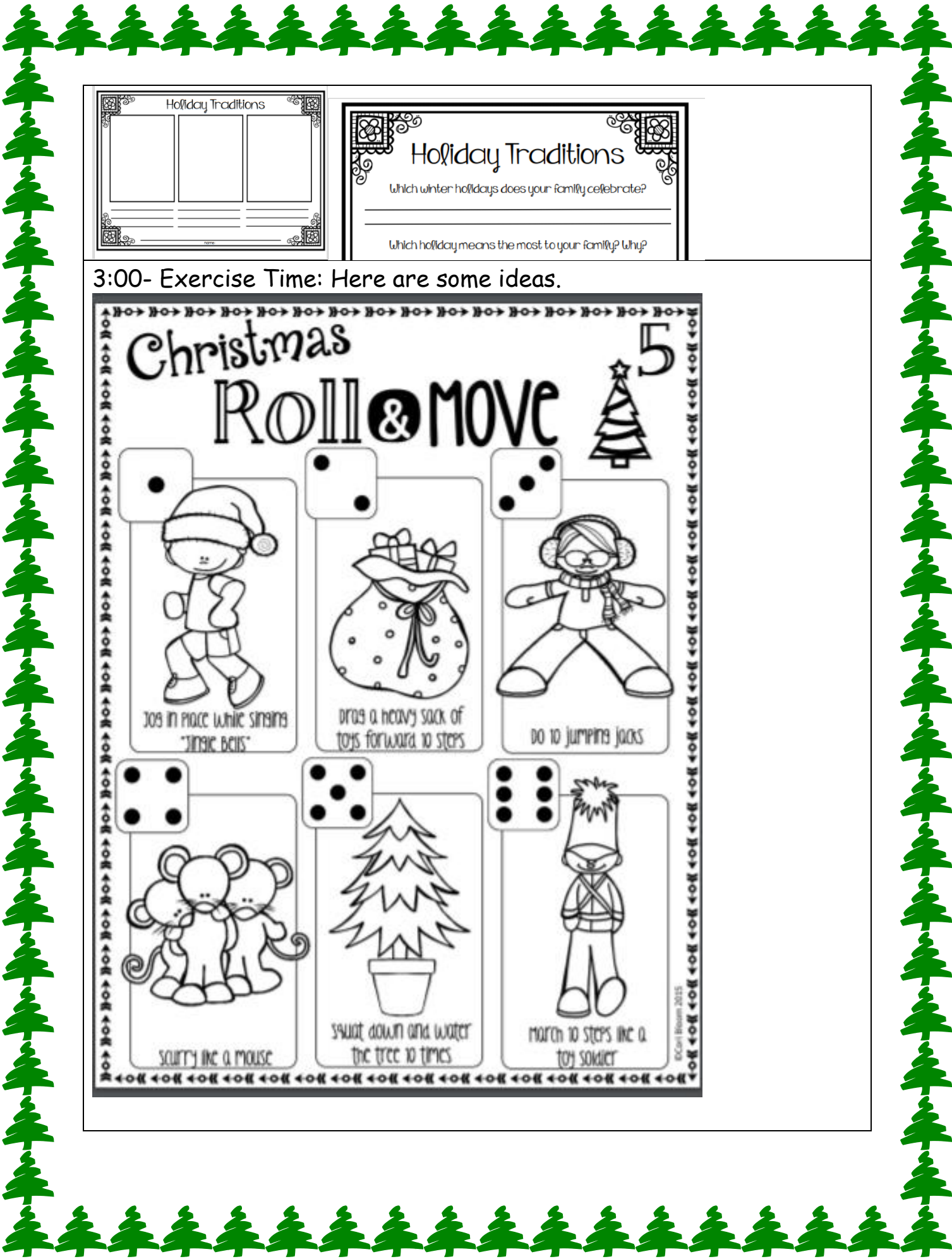
