Chickens have pointed beaks.  
Their feet are sharp.  
Ducks have flat beaks.  
Their feet have webs of skin.  
Ducks use their feet to swim.  
Ducks find food in the water.  
Chickens cannot swim.  
They use their beaks and feet to dig up food.
