


We have Teams meetings today at 8:30, 10:30, and 1:00.

Black Bear	Racoon		This animal is a scavenger and will dig through garbage cans. It eats plants and small animals and does not hibernate all winter.	This animal prefers to live in forests near water. They are often seen as pests because they eat garbage and can escape traps.
Red Fox	Flying Squirrel		This animal lives in all provinces across Canadal It is a very good hunter. They mostly live alone but travel with their young. Their sandy red colour gives them their name.	This animal cannot fly, but it glides when it spreads its legs. It can glide from tree to tree to travel guickly and stay safe.
Moose	Snow Crab		This animal travels across Canada looking for food. Sometimes it travels far north to the territories. It eats twigs green plants and buds.	These animals are crustaceans which means that they have a hard protective shell. They can grow up to two feet long!
Blue Whale	Harbour Seal		This is the largest animal on Earth! They travel in groups of two or three and are found in the Pacific and Atlantic Oceans.	This animal is found on most Canadian coastlnes. It is a skilled diver and is also very playful. They eat mostly fish.
Orca Whale	Northern Leopard Frog		This animal lives in cooler waters and travels in large packs. They travel in large groups so they can hunt larger prey, like whales.	This medium-sized amphibian is common across Canada and lives mostly in ponds, marshes and gnasslands.
