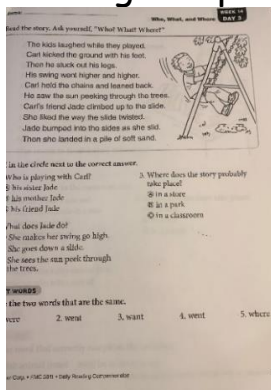

### Designing My Thermos!

**Instructions:**
