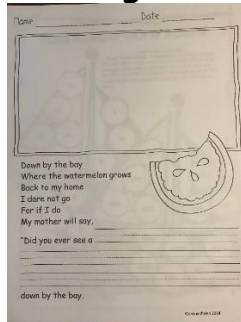

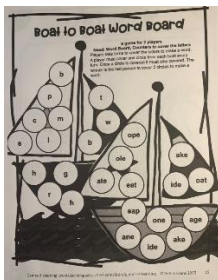
2. Read to self- Print books, online books.

3. Reading Fun: Think of your own Down by the Bay Rhyme after listening to the song in class.



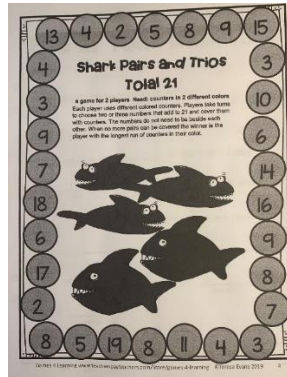
4. Play the Boat game. You will need 2 kinds of counters. It could be beans and noodles. Etc.
